

Lower School Autumn Topic Overview 2019

Our topic this term is - Farms

ENGLISH

We will be exploring texts based on farms including poetry, non-fiction, traditional tales and instructions. We also have a visiting theatre company coming to perform Michael Morpurgo's 'I Believe In Unicorns' for us!

MATHS

This term we will be focusing on place value, addition and subtraction and functional measures. Each week we will also be looking at time and money.

SCIENCE

In science we will be finding out about lifecycles linked with our farms topic, we will be finding out about the lifecycles of chickens, humans and tadpoles.

GEOGRAPHY/HISTORY

Through the topic of farming we will be answering questions that the children want to know about. We will look at where farms are and how people farmed in the past.

PE

In PE we will be learning how to control our movement. We will learn how to negotiate space successfully and working with others.

Art/DT

In art and DT we will be recording observations and experience linked to our topic on farming. We will also be learning how to create collages.

PSHE/RE

In PSHE we will learn about physical wellbeing, exploring food, being active, personal safety and sun safety. Who do Christians say made the world?

ICT/MUSIC

In ICT we will be learning how to use the iPad to connect with others and share information, we will be developing skills in using the camera and photo apps. In music we will be using the sounds of the farm to create a composition.
