4	80.199	Budget/Finance /structure	AR presented budget scenarios A-H to the Governing Board. In 2017, the deficit was predicted to be £514,000. We are now looking at a deficit of approximately £40,000. In 2019 we predicted an in-year deficit of £101,000 so have saved approximately £60,000 across the year. However this might change if we are not able to get a VELP loan.	AR
			KH asked where the core offer figures come from and if it was comparable to other schools? AR there are no school which we compare to. AR looked at what it would take to get us into a 'profitable' budget. SJB thanked her predecessor for the work that was put in to the document which demonstrated the cost of educating a student at Lampard and was submitted to the LA. Against this we still have made considerable savings off a desirable core offer to take the school out of a deficit in 5 years and having building work to increase numbers to 180 (scenario H)	

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			EH asked how can you increase a core offer and why don't we get it? AR said that we have to submit to DCC what we need in terms of pupil funding, however various departments have to agree that we can receive this before any increase would happen. SJB said that we receive the second lowest core funding for special schools and independent provisions across the county. KH the increased core offer and no strategic build will we be sustainable? AR said it would be sustainable if we receive investment from the LA, but it wouldn't be sustainable in our current environment. CB said that scenario H is more favourable but depends on gaining more students and increase in core offer. How confident are we that we will get this? KH is more confident based on the commitment recently from DCC. We have to present Scenario A however the school would prefer Scenario H. AR will work more thoroughly on the scenario that is chosen by governors to provide a more accurate picture of the budget and what we can provide. SLT are working on our school designation so that the LA are clear on what students we can provide education for. KH said it is remarkable in the current climate to have reduced the deficit. SJB added that we also still have a strong school and have been achieving great things which have been externally verified and audited. Governors decided to present the LA with Scenario A and Scenario H Governors agreed for AR to submit our budget to the LA AR to bring breakdown of A and H to next governor meeting AR to submit budget to DCC
