Summary of how PPG was spent in previous academic year [2014/15]

Purchased an increased range of practical resources to support learning in both literacy and numeracy, for use in small group and individual sessions during Personal Programmes and timetabled literacy and numeracy sessions.

Provided staffing for small group and individual sessions as above by increasing the TA support levels in those classes which included Year 7 students.

Objectives in spending PPG for current academic year:

Research and purchase additional web based access to learning programmes supporting learning in both literacy and numeracy. These to be suitable for use by individuals in both supported and independent sessions, including home access via the school website.

Continue to build an increased range of practical resources to support learning in both literacy and numeracy.

Provide training for staff on interventions, in particular, assistive technology interventions

Provide staffing for small group and individual sessions in literacy and numeracy, targeting Year 7 students.

Summary of planned spending and actions taken for current academic year (2015-16):

Purchase of IT resources - £2,950

Purchase of numeracy training – developing additive reasoning - £600 [one teacher/3 TAs]

Contribution towards provision of additional Teaching Assistant time in five class groups for 4 lessons per week [2 x literacy and 2 x numeracy] @ £12 per hour for 36 weeks - £3,950
