














St Georges House Kit List (MS Residential)

The residential trip will soon be here! Here is a checklist of what is recommended by St Georges House and ourselves to safely take part in all elements of the residential.


ALL luggage must be brought into school on Thursday 20th April (group 1) or Monday 24th April (group 2) so that we can check that all students have everything they need for a fun and safe trip.

- Pillow Case
- Duvet Cover/Sleeping bag
- Toiletries
- Sun cream
- Hat
- Old trainers- Shoes that can get wet (not wellies or flip flops)
- Water bottle (labelled + screw top)
- 2 x Towels (one for showering, one for activities)
- Waterproof jacket (plus trousers if owned)
- Warm clothes
- Change of clothes (enough for 3 days)
- Pyjamas
- Underwear & socks (enough for 3 days)
- Wellies

*Can all kit brought be labelled or initialled to help with lost property at the end of the week.

School policy is not to allow phones or cameras. Should you need to contact your son/daughter whilst we are away, please contact school.

If anyone does bring a phone or camera it will be confiscated for the duration of the residential.



*if you think your child will not eat any of the items form the menu can you please contact their tutor and discuss an alternative request that we can give to St George's House (this must be done in advance). If your child has a restrictive diet, we request you provide that food item for your child during their stay.
