

Dear Parent & Carers

Re: Measles, Chicken Pox, Shingles.

Please may we ask for your co-operation in a vitally important matter?

One of our pupils is receiving medical treatment that puts them at serious risk if exposed to measles, chicken pox or shingles.

The best way to protect a pupil from measles is for all pupils to be immunised.

Please discuss measles immunisation with your GP if your child is not already vaccinated.

If you suspect your child has measles you should let the school know immediately.

Our pupil is also at risk from chicken pox and would need to be given treatment as soon possible after contact.

Please let us know immediately if you suspect that your child has chicken pox.

It is also very important that you let us know if anyone in your household has shingles.

Your child is not at any risk whatsoever from this situation. However, the health and wellbeing of our pupil may be at serious risk.

We depend on the co-operation of all parents and know we can rely on your help.
