# **Expectations – Lampard Community School**

## ***You can expect us to:***

- Provide your child with learning experiences tailored to their individual need (in line with the learning objectives in their statement).
- With consultation, set targets for your child; these should be realistic, achievable and challenging.
- Encourage your child to behave towards others in an acceptable, appropriate manner.
- Inform you of your child's progress through parents' evenings; review and end of year reports.
- Communicate with you regularly through the home/school diary or planner system; regular newsletters and phone calls (where necessary).
- Work with you, in line with our behaviour policy, to address any individual behaviour difficulties.
- Sometimes provide homework. This will be tailored to meet the needs and capabilities of individuals. Homework should support skills learnt in earlier lessons.
- Provide a happy, secure, stimulating learning environment.

## ***We expect you to:***

- Ensure your child attends school regularly.
- Contact school when your child is unwell/not attending for any reason.
- Support your child's development, particularly by reading with them at home on a regular basis.
- Encourage a positive attitude towards homework but not to do the work for your child. Homework should not cause your child anxiety. If there are any concerns please contact school as soon as possible.
- Reinforce attitudes and behaviours that encourage good citizenship and agreeable relationships with others.

## ***We expect your child to:***

- Attend school regularly.
- Adhere to the uniform code.
- Work hard.
- Treat others and belongings with respect.
