Admissions

Lampard Community School is a local authority maintained special school whose provision meets the needs of students with significant needs in the area of communication and interaction needs and this is specified in their Education Health Care Plan.

Students have a diagnosis of autism and/or have needs relating to speech, language and communication. Due to their communication needs and cognitive abilities, students are working well below age-related expectations.

The school takes children from between the ages of 5 and 16 years.

Lampard Community School works closely with the Local Authority regarding any potential admissions to the school. We are mindful of:

The Special Educational Needs and Disability code of practice 0-25 years (July 2014)

The Equality Act (2010)

The Children and Families Act (2014)

Every child or young person admitted to Lampard Community School will have an Education, Health and Care Plan (EHCP).

Through the Education Health Care Plan, the SEN 0-25 team specify the provision required for each student and how education, health and care services will work together to meet a students' needs to support the achievement of agreed outcomes for each pupil.

As a maintained school, Lampard Community School is not authorised to offer placements, places are commissioned by the SEN 0-25 team and can only be offered by them.
