



English, Language and Communication

- *The Great Pet Sale* by Mick Inkpen will help us to think about the ideal pet for us. We will then explore factual texts and literature to create our own instructions for caring for pets.

Mathematics, Science and DT

- In our maths we will be improving our counting and number skills to help us calculate. We will learn about telling the time and how to make simple charts to show what we have found out.

Our Pets

- Students learn about animals close to and in the home, with a particular focus on the pets we keep and how we keep them happy and healthy

Personal Development and Digital Literacy

- PE - Swimming/Walking/Treasure Hunts
Students will learn safety in swimming and working to improve water confidence. Walking for fitness and life skills.
- In ICT we will focus on Presenting Information.
- In PSHE we will continue to focus on growing and changing looking at body changes that happen to boys and girls during puberty. We will also be looking at keeping our bodies and minds healthy.
